MESSAGE FROM THE VICE CHANCELLOR





After what the year has held for so many people here, to be able to have an occasion where people could express their joy and pride was certainly an antidote to some of the things that have happened this year.




FY'22 BY THE NUMBERS (Audited)







An Unplanned Visit Changed the Course of My Life — and Hopefully the World

hen we first visited the Holy Land, visiting Bethlehem University wasn't in our itinerary.

Our tour leader surprised us with a trip to Bethlehem itself and a stop at the University. It was to be an unplanned moment that changed the course of my life and opened my heart in ways I never expected.

As people of faith, we tend to have an image of Bethlehem like we see in Christmas cards – gentle and quiet and soft. It was nothing like I thought it would be. Never before, and never since, have I been on a tour bus where two armed soldiers entered to visually assess passengers and (for some) check their passports. It struck me immediately just how prevalent it is that this is a city behind a wall, under constant guard. I thought to myself, "I am really in a war zone – physically and spiritually."

When we arrived at the University there were very few people. Unlike many American universities, students don't live on campus. They have to pass through those same checkpoints and security measures that we did – every single day they come to class.

That day we were told it was simply too dangerous for the students to come to campus, despite it being surrounded by a very thick and foreboding wall.

The few students I did get to speak with touched my heart in ways I cannot fully express. The gifts of adversity and the gift of hope and optimism all reside in the same space with these students. The stories they told me of the adversity they've had to overcome, while at the same time working so hard to achieve a future they dream of, are nothing short of inspirational.

Brother Peter Bray says he feels that Bethlehem University is an Oasis of Peace. A place where students can feel safe. I am so deeply honored and grateful to be a part of helping create that place of safety, that place of peace, and helping a student reach a future of opportunity and hope.



I am also tremendously grateful to be a part of helping young women achieve the dreams and hopes they aspire to. My dear mother, Jane Bey, herself an educator as I was, always said, "When you educate a boy, you educate a man. When you educate a girl, you educate a family." It is powerful and moving to hear the stories of young Palestinian women, not afraid to take on the adversity of getting to campus and pursuing their education.

I truly believe that fundraising isn't about burdening people to share – it's about gifting people the opportunity to help. I am grateful that you share in that opportunity with me. I am honored that you, too, choose to support Bethlehem University, supporting the hope and endurance it promises until we can all live in a world full of Peace.



arah Soudah, from Jerusalem, is a senior majoring in medical laboratory sciences. He came to campus shortly before the pandemic hit and, like so many students, feared he would lose contact with his friends and classmates. "Bethlehem University introduced me to the Palestinian community from other cities and little towns I had never heard of!"

Being a part of Bethlehem University is not just about the rigor of academics but, for many students, it broadens their horizons in unexpected ways. Students build life-long relationships with classmates who, share the same fears and concerns, goals and dreams, and hope for the future.

Like many, too, Farah had to endure passing through checkpoints every day to reach to the University. While discouraged he would not be seeing his friends, the move to online teaching during the pandemic offered one small bright spot – less time commuting and having to endure the trials of passing through security cordons and checkpoints.





Faculty Recognized for Excellence in Research

Bethlehem University's faculty continue to receive the highest accolades and recognition from all over the world. Professor Jamil Khader, Dean of Research and Professor of English, received the 2022 Arab American University Award for Excellence in Scientific Research in the category of Humanities and Sciences.

Professor Khader was recognized for his research and published article examining the artistic, cultural, and political significance of the Walled-Off Hotel in Bethlehem to the Palestinian struggle for freedom.

Often called "the hotel with the worst view in the world," it has emerged as one of the most important living cultural heritage and national memory sites in Palestine. In Professor Khader's research, he finds the hotel portrays the horrors of the occupation and reframes the Palestinian narrative and message to international audiences.

Bethlehem University's faculty members continue to emerge not only as leaders in academic instruction, but are at the forefront of research in subject areas from the sciences to the humanities. Their commitment and dedication prepare students for careers and life, bolstered by support from the Foundation.



Education for Care and Reconciliation

Professors from the Faculty of Education and other areas at Bethlehem University participated in programs offered by the Foundation for Reconciliation, a not-for-profit association helping in processes of reconciliation and conflict resolution while working for sustainable peace.

"As Dean of Education, it would be a dream for me to be able to provide formation in care and reconciliation to all our students – future teachers! – so they benefit from it themselves," Brother Alejandro González Cerna said. "Students would then share its fruits with their families and communities as they also go to their own students and help them grow and develop in a holistic way."

Begun by Fr. Leonel Narváez Gómez in Colombia, the Foundation for Reconciliation was created to help heal and unite Colombian citizens in the aftermath of cartel-related violence. Bethlehem University's faculty were able to meet with Fr. Leonel himself and inform their work in the complex and challenging situation that is Palestine.

Dr. Barakat is a leading expert in reconciliation, conflict resolution, and issues affecting the Palestinian people and women.

In 2017, she moved to Ramallah, Palestine to teach violin at the prestigious Edward Said National Conservatory of Music. She is a dedicated advocate for Palestinian rights and continues to collaborate with today's artists and cultural leaders in Palestine.

Foundation Hires New Director of Development

ethlehem University Foundation's new Director of Development, Kathleen Carver, brings a rich background of fundraising, leadership, and nonprofit management. She is highly committed to excellence, integrity, innovation, and Catholic values.

Most recently, Kathy was the Director of Institutional Advancement for the Saint Luke Institute where she secured a \$500,000 gift from a private family foundation and led the restructuring of the Advancement department. Dr. Joseph Bock, Executive Director of Bethlehem University Foundation, while reflecting on Kathy's new appointment, said: "The Foundation is delighted to welcome such a polished and accomplished professional as Kathy to our team. Kathy's other experience includes securing a \$200,000 grant for the National Federation for Catholic Youth Ministry (NFCYM), leading a four-year long strategic planning process, and developing over 75 revenue-producing educational materials for Catholic youth and youth and family ministers. She served for 23 years as the organizations' Associate Director.

With a deep commitment to social justice, Kathy sees the opportunity to work for Bethlehem University Foundation as an occasion to offset the disparity experienced by Palestinian youth and young adults. Education can be a key factor for graduates to secure fulfilling jobs, lead dignified lives, and be positive influences in their local communities.



In 1964, Pope Paul VI visited the Holy Land and left with a desire on his heart to help the Palestinian people. There was an ongoing exodus of Palestinians, and those who stayed faced significant restrictions, a lack of housing, few job opportunities, and no university education available in Palestine. Those who left to attend university elsewhere usually did not return.

In 1971, Monsignor Pio Laghi, the Apostolic Delegate of the Vatican in Jerusalem, met with leaders of Christian schools in Jerusalem and Bethlehem. He reiterated Pope Paul VI's wishes. It seemed there was a strong need for teachers, so an initial suggestion of a teacher training college was put forward. Brother Jean Manual FSC offered the use of the De La Salle Brothers' Bethlehem property.

On October 1, 1973, three De La Salle Brothers, in a joint venture with the Vatican, joined with a group of Palestinians and 112 students to begin Bethlehem University, the first registered university in Palestine.

As we celebrate our Jubilee, 50 years of providing excellence in higher education to the Palestinian people, we know it is our many supporters, donors, and friends who have made this important work possible. Now a leading international institution of higher education, the over 17,000 Bethlehem University alumni are working in Palestine, pursuing advanced degrees and conducting cutting-edge research, and sharing their stories of perseverance and courage in the face of adversity and injustice throughout the world.
